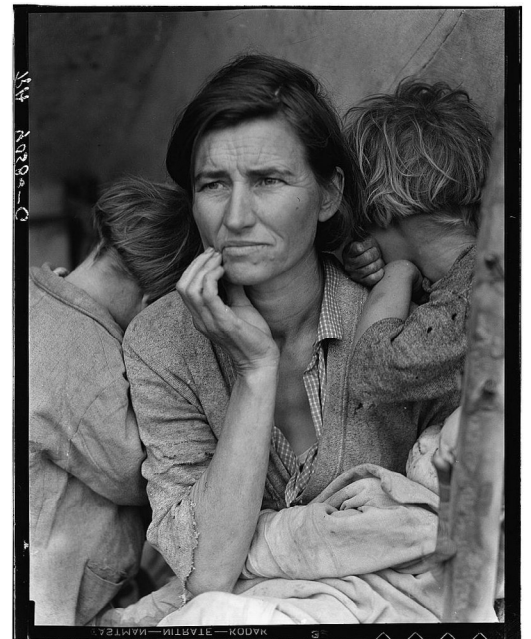
Classes run April 10 - June 3

Cinema 107 - Understanding Motion Pictures (3 units)
